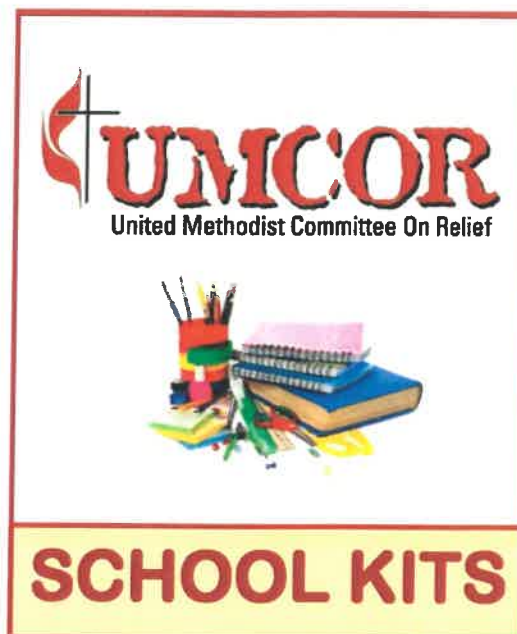

Good Shepherd Ministries will hold its First Annual Cornhole Tournament at Wheeler United Methodist Church (211 N Sanders Street, Blountville, TN) on Saturday, November 18th.

The indoor, double elimination tournament will begin at 11a.m.. Food, drinks and baked goods will be available for purchase. Entry fees are \$25.00 per team with cash prizes for the top three teams; \$200 for first, \$100.00 for second and \$50.00 for third. Registration can be done by mail with entry fees sent to: Good Shepherd Ministries, P.O. Box 2185, Bristol, TN, 37820 or teams may register the day of the tournament.

All proceeds from the tournament will support Good Shepherd's water and livestock missions work in Zimbabwe, Africa. An extensive water project has been developed to provide water for the village of Dzobo, Zimbabwe. In addition to clean drinking water for the people of the village and nearby school, cisterns will provide water for livestock and farming. Proceeds will also provide funds to build a chicken house at Ishe Anesu school in Matare, Zimbabwe. The school serves 70 plus HIV afflicted and impoverished children. The chickens will not only provide food but the possibility for additional financial assistance. Brian Johnson, the director of Good Shepherd Ministries said, "Water is life and the project in Dzobo will bring life to so many of our African sisters and brothers in need. The chicken house at the school will provide food so the children there can learn and break through the cycle of poverty. Both projects help us share the Good News of Jesus Christ."
