

Middlebrook Pike United Methodist Church seeks a Director of Children's Music. This is a part-time position. Candidate will be responsible for comprehensive children's music program. Primary responsibilities include:

- Direct children's "Friendship choir" (Grades 3-5)
- Recruit leaders for the other children's choirs (two choral groups and one hand bell group) and provide leadership and support for these ministries. (Cherub choir 3yrs – kindergarten, Angel Choir 1st – 2nd grade)
- Serve as a resource/contact person to all leaders of children's choirs.
- Facilitate the fall registration process for all children's musical groups.
- Work with the other music staff and pastors, scheduling performances at the beginning of the school year for all worship services and special programs.
- Ensure that audio/visual technical support and needed facility accommodations have been arranged for scheduled performances.
- Publish and print programs for combined performances at Christmas and spring.
- Provide music information for worship guides to office staff in a timely manner.
- Support children's Sunday school by leading singing during assembly using song selections appropriate for rotation themes.
- Direct VBS music and end-of-week program
- Participate in BMM on Wednesday evening.

Qualifications:

- Understand children's development, including faith and musical skills and demonstrate sensitivity to the needs of children.
- Strong planning and organizational skills with ability to lead, delegate and work with volunteers.
- Ability to work as a member of a team with staff, committees, and church members.
- Bachelors of Music Education or Bachelors of Music is preferred.
- 2-3 years' experience working with children preferred.
- Appreciation of traditional and contemporary music styles.
