

2016 is a very special year for Jubilee as it marks 25 years of ministry to the people of Hancock County. For 25 years Jubilee has endeavored to do ministry with this vision in mind. We have sought God's guidance in finding ways to

empower the people here and shine the light of God's love to bring hope into their lives.

What shape the ministry has taken over the years has varied as staff members have changed and brought their own gifts and graces, but this vision statement has remained at its core. As a staff, we continue to pray for God's guidance to meet the changing needs of the community as each year brings new challenges into the lives of the people here. We would ask your prayers for us as we seek God's will for the ministry.

As a way of celebrating this 25-year milestone, we are a planning a series of 4 celebrations, each targeting a different audience. Each celebration will have a service component.
