In addition, each congregation must provide for ministry in the areas of Nurture, Outreach, and Witness. The individual ministries included in each of these areas are specified in paragraph 252.2 of *The 2016 Book of Discipline of The United Methodist Church*. Your congregation may use the combination of ministries as listed in this paragraph of the Discipline or modify the organization to fit your particular needs. As you identify your leadership needs, your committee on Nominations and Leadership Development will nominate the necessary chairpersons and committees. Please provide the names of all chairpersons on form 3 of this packet entitled Officers, Leaders, and Employed Staff. Please provide a complete listing of *all persons* providing leadership in your local church for your Charge Conference.
